

Natural Gas will be Available in Ballinrobe by Autumn

Bord Gáis Networks has confirmed that it has secured the gas load levels required to support the investment in infrastructure to bring natural gas to the town. A construction programme will be developed over the coming weeks and construction of the natural gas pipeline to Ballinrobe is expected to commence within the next two months, with natural

gas flowing in the autumn. This is a €4m investment for Ballinrobe and is part of the €50m Gaswest Project to develop the natural gas network in the West of Ireland.

In November 2007 Bord Gáis Networks confirmed that, subject to achieving commitments that met the level of demand required, Ballinrobe would be con-

nected to the natural gas network. Speaking about the efforts that have been made since then, Mark Holohan explains: "The Bord Gáis Networks Connections Team has worked very closely with the local business community to ensure that Ballinrobe is connected to the natural gas network. We have met regularly with individual business owners to assess

their requirements, present the economic, environmental and efficiency benefits of natural gas and to develop quotations for each business to ensure that sufficient demand was secured. I am delighted to announce these plans today and look forward to working with the business community to ensure they can avail of natural gas, the most competitively-priced

fuel for industry." The first phase of the construction programme will see the installation of the 22km feeder main to the town from the connection point on the 149km Mayo-Galway transmission pipeline, followed by the construction of 4km of distribution mains within the town itself. Natural gas is scheduled to flow by autumn 2009.
